**M**exico City: climb ancient pyramids of Teotihuacan (see photo); see Frida Kahlo's house and her beautiful, bizarre art; walk around the zocalo with the Metropolitan Cathedral, Aztec ruins, and the colorful murals of Diego Rivera

**O**axaca City: wander Monte Alban (grand Zapotec ruins on the top of a mountain); explore cobblestone streets and markets famous for chocolates, cheeses, and textiles; relax listening to live music in the zocalo in the evening; and much more

**P**uerto Escondido: swim at tropical beaches and wander huge markets: beautiful place to lounge on the beach, jump in the surf, and relax

**P**inotepa Nacional: discover gem unknown to most travellers participate in lively festivals with folk music and cultural convergence of African Mexicans, white Mexicans, and Mixtec people (some still dressing and speaking in native way)

On this tour we'll be staying in youth hostels and simple hotels. We'll go to top tourist spots but we'll also ride on great local transport and explore and eat at markets where only locals go and the food is delicious and authentic! It will be a supportive environment during the trip and I'll be available before and after the trip to help with preparation and readjusting to being home.
